Donate Milk

Visit www.milkbankwgl.org to fill out a Donor Interest Form. We will reach out to complete a 10-15 minute phone screening. If you are a candidate for donation, we will send you our full donor application.

Complete the application. Milk Bank WGL will review your application and contact your medical providers.

Milk Bank WGL will arrange for blood testing at no cost to you. It can take 5-7 business days for results.

Once you are approved, we will give you a donor number. We will work with you to find a convenient depot location to drop off your frozen milk or find other shipping/transport options.

The full screening process can take up to 2-3 weeks to complete.

Donation requirements differ for mothers who donate after loss. Please call our donor relations team at 847-262-5134 for more information about our **special bereavement program**.

Access Donor Milk

Need milk? Donor milk may be used at home for many reasons, including low milk supply, surrogacy, adoption, or as part of a health treatment plan.

You can easily obtain donor milk from a dispensary or directly from Milk Bank WGL.

Please note: a prescription for donor milk may be required; insurance billing is evaluated on a case-by-case basis.

Donor milk is primarily used in NICU and Mother Baby Units in Wisconsin and Illinois hospitals. Available milk is prioritized so that the most fragile babies always receive milk first.
