Blood Draw

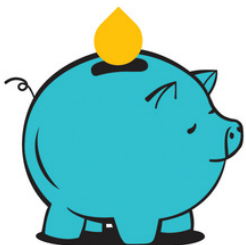
Have a blood test, paid for by Milk Bank WGL.

You Can Save Tiny Lives!

You can save tiny lives by donating your extra breast milk. Your milk contains unique ingredients that strengthen a premature baby's immune system to help them fight disease. Some mothers of premature babies can't produce the amount of milk their baby needs. These babies depend on the generosity of milk donors like you who have extra milk to share.

Donor Milk Use & Safety

- The American Academy of Pediatrics recommends donor milk as the next best option for premature babies when their own mother's milk is not available.
- Milk donors are screened and tested for infectious diseases.
- The milk is heat treated to kill bacteria and viruses.
- The milk is tested at a lab before it is delivered to the babies that need it.
